99 years! For 99 years, the DuBois Public Library has been serving the community first through book & newspapers, and now through books, DVDs, computers, OverDrive eBooks, programs for all ages, and so much more. Almost 100 years ago, the City of DuBois decided they needed a library to support the educational and entertainment of the DuBois Community. 33 years later, the DuBois Community decided they wanted to help the City of DuBois support their library and so, created the Friends of the DuBois Public Library. For 66 years, the Friends of the Library has been helping our Community Library through financial support, program creation, and just by being library enthusiasts.

The Staff and Trustees of the DuBois Public Library welcome the Community of DuBois to the Friends of the Library group. Our library was founded to benefit the community by providing reading material that families may not otherwise be able to afford, and our mission hasn't changed much since 1920. Over the last 96 years, the library has served the City of DuBois and Sandy Township residents by providing books, videos, audiobooks and music, and

various technology. Currently, the DuBois Public Library houses over 41,000 items including fiction, non-fiction, audiobooks, DVDs, and magazines for adults, young adults, and children. The DuBois Public Library also provides a collection of special materials including PA History, large-print books, and Parent-Teacher materials on Child Development and Education. Many informational databases are available through the library's website, as well as downloadable audiobooks and eBooks. Public internet access and WIFI are available to everyone.

The DuBois Public Library also offers educational and entertainment opportunities to the Community, including story times for children, STEM activities for children & teens, book discussion activities for teens, and various opportunities throughout the summer and school year. Summer reading will begin again in June 2019, with reading and program opportunities for all ages.
